VOLUNTEERS ARE NOW NEEDED DURING CONSTRUCTION!

Volunteers are needed for most aspects of the construction as listed on the back of this sheet. Pick your favorite interests and sign up to work with your fellow parishioners!

- * **Normal Work Days** are Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays. (*See Schedule on back*)
- * **A Typical Work Day** starts at 8:15 am; Break at 10; Lunch at noon; Clean Up at 3:30 pm
- * **Habitat Provides:** Coffee and water, all work tools, all safety equipment, safety and work training. Specific guidelines and information will be provided in advance to each volunteer. You may bring your own hand tools, but no power tools may be used except those that Habitat provides.
- * **Lunch** is provided on most Saturday BUILD days. Plan to bring your own lunch during the week.
- * **Type of Work:** We need volunteers of all skill levels from no construction skills to highly trained construction workers, lunch crews, site hosts and snack-makers! See the back of this sheet for construction activities to find your favorite volunteer position and schedule!
- * **Age of Volunteers:** must be at least 16 years old to enter the BUILD site. Students between 16 & 18 years old must be accompanied by a Parent or Guardian. *See limitations on the back of this sheet.*
- * **What To Do:** 1) **Fill in** the FORM below. 2) **Review the Schedule** on the back of this sheet and check all boxes of volunteer areas that you would like to help in. 3) **Make a copy** of your information.
- 4) **Turn in your Sign-Up Form** at SIGN-UP SUNDAY at your parish or mail it to the address on the bottom of this sheet. Call any of the Volunteer Coordinators as listed at the bottom of this sheet with questions or talk to your parish representative at SIGN-UP SUNDAY on February 20th and 21st.

WHAT KIND OF VOLUNTEER ARE YOU?

- ✓ **General Crew** = Helper for a day, no construction skills are necessary (*training is provided*)
- ✓ **Trained Crew** = Crew Leader for a day, some construction skills ARE needed
- ✓ **Lunch Team** = You or your group can provide lunch for (30 people) for a day. Mostly on Saturdays 11:30am-2pm
- ✓ **Snack Team** = Make Healthy Snacks for 30+ people and deliver to BUILD site -or- Make Snacks at the Habitat offices!
- ✓ **Site Host** = Greet and Orientate other volunteers, assist with Registration & Lunch. 8AM-2PM

* No Volunteers under the age of 18 are allowed on the construction site on the activities listed with a *.
